CRAZY 8

...reads the tag line for the Crazy 8 show, summing up the wide range of physical approaches to art featured at this event. Crazy 8 brings together eight local gay artists who all work in surprising ways with both traditional and non-traditional art media. Curated by artists and participants Jason Messinger and Alan Emerson Hicks, the artwork showcased is "crazy in the wild sense, not totally insane!" says Messinger. "The work isn't gay themed necessarily. But the work is gay in sensibility, in that it concerns beauty, sensitivity, emotional connection, a sense of something bigger than oneself, and also a sense of one's own personal world view as being important and worth sharing. That's gay in my book."

We chatted with Messinger about the show and his approach to his work... and you are part of it.

Nightspots: On your Web site, you speak about how the artists in the show work in a variety of different media, but share a streak of vibrant energy and emotion. When putting together the show, was this your intention or did it just pan out this way?

Jason Messinger: When Alan Emerson Hicks and I first planned the show, we knew we wanted artwork that spoke not only to the audience, but also to the other art in the show. The dialogue of the contrasts and similarities between these artistic visions is a large part of what makes Crazy 8 such an interesting event. Many of the artists use intensely patterned surfaces and vibrant colors. Some layer materials on top of each other, or cut the original surface apart before they reassemble the work. Some have focused the viewer's attention to the physical process of making a mark on canvas or paper or clay. Emotional connection, visual stimulation and wildness are all qualities the artists share.

NS: Your work allows the owner to rearrange the elements, thus changing the narrative. How important do you think the viewer's interpretation is to the overall work of art?

JM: I have always been interested in art that straddles both the "cool" allure of pure abstraction and the "hot" recognition of representational art. I want the viewer to bring their own history and visual play into interpreting my work. Even when the artwork is clearly representational, like the tile series of hand-painted images of utility poles, I want the viewer to have their own feelings on what the piece is about. To me, art is a dialogue between the artist and their culture, and each viewer should bring their own desires and dreams when looking.

NS: Tell us a little about your work? Where might we have encountered your work before?

JM: At this show I will be unveiling a new selection of tile murals which I am very excited about. I also make ceramic sculpture and paintings and drawings on paper. I have shown professionally in Chicago and around the country, and I am in collections across the US and in Europe. My art studio and showroom is in the Cornelia Arts Building here in Chicago. Recently I was awarded a commission at the Chicago Public Library, Austin Irving Branch, which houses two of my 8' x 5' ceramic tile murals.

NS: Had you worked with any of the featured artists previously?

JM: We personally knew all the artists and have worked with all of them. Many of them are good friends, but this isn't a buddy show. These eight artists all share something special that I think the audience will appreciate.
